Statit piMD 3.0 contains more than 30 enhancements including:

- **My Indicators** – Allows users to identify which indicators are currently the most relevant to them and to display those indicators in dashboards, scorecards or a “trend matrix” (comparative information).
- **Subscriptions** – Users can choose if/how they want to be notified when user-specific rules are violated (SPC alarms, targets not met, etc.) or if the Process Expert adds/changes anything associated with the indicator (new comment/action plans, identifies process phases, etc.). This just-in-time delivery of critical information closes the improvement loop and allows processes to get better, quicker.
- **Process Phases** – Process Experts can initiate a new process phase after a corrective action intervention to determine if the process is demonstrating the desired result. Statistical significance testing helps the user understand if the change really had an effect.
- **Indicator Publishing** – Allows users to publish multiple indicators to MS Word or other file types. Templates can be easily defined to control the layout and content of the generated output.
- **New Comparison Techniques** – Additional comparison techniques are now available to help identify which facility, unit, physician is “really” different from the rest.
